KEY STEPS

1. Keep calm

2. Always have your cell phone charged and with you to avoid losing communications.

FIRES

REMEMBER THERE IS A FIRE EXTINGUISHER IN THE HALL

- 1. Call the administration office and 911.
- 2. Cut the electricity and gas.
- 3. If the fire is near electrical contacts, do not try to extinguish the fire with water.
- 4. Exit the apartment and notify your next-door neighbors.
- 5. If the fire prevents your departure, lock yourself in a room, cover the door with damp rags and let yourself be seen through the window.

MEDICAL

- 1. Call the administration office and 911.
- 2. Follow the instructions given by the administration.
- 3. Alert your neighbors for assistance if possible.

HURRICANE

1. Before the arrival of the hurricane

- a. Confirm with the office the expected arrival date and time of the hurricane
- b. Keep important documents in a plastic bag and locked.
- c. Protect window glass with "X" shaped tape or wood.
- d. Disconnect all electrical devices.

2. During the hurricane:

- a. Confirm with the office your presence and anyone else in your condo.
- b. Stay away from windows and find a safe place such as door frames or bathroom
- c. When the "eye of the hurricane" arrives, avoid leaving, the worst part is yet to come.
- 3. After the hurricane:
- a. Call the office to report on the welfare of everyone in your condo.
- b. Check your condo for damage, take pictures and report broken glass to the office.
- c. Call your personal insurance agency for other damage

EARTHOUAKE

1. Preventive measures to take:

- a. If possible, participate in the simulations provided by the office.
- b. Locate the safest places in your apartment (under the door frames for example).
- c. Always have bottled water, canned food, batteries, flashlight and first aid kit.

2. During the earthquake:

- a. Advise the office of your presence and try to remain calm.
- b. Leave the apartment and look for a clear place at least 30 meters from buildings and away from power cables.
- c. If you are trapped, try to make noise to alert others to your location.

3. After the earthquake:

- a. Check everyone for injuries and report to the office. Call 911 if necessary. Stay hydrated with bottled water
- b. Report any damage of your condo to the office and take photos of any damage
- c. Report damage to your insurance company and to the office.
